May. 30, 2019 | China Chinese Officials Shut Down Large House Church

A large, unregistered house church in Beijing was formally shut down on Saturday, March 23, after an extended battle with Chinese officials. The Shouwang Church first ran into trouble with the government in 2008, when they were evicted from a rented property. Since then, they have been meeting outdoors and in smaller venues across the city, while Pastor Jin Tianming has spent the last seven years under house arrest. The church had attempted to register with the government in 2006, but their application was rejected because they insisted on making God the center of the church rather than the Communist Party. Pray for the wisdom of believers in this church.
